Steps to a Make Good Confession

- 1. Carefully examine your conscience.
- 2. Be sincerely sorry for your sins.
- 3. Make a firm resolution to not sin again and to avoid the near occasions of sin.
- 4. Tell your sins to the priest. All unconfessed mortal sins, of which you are aware, must be confessed by kind & number as best you can.
- 5. Say an Act of Contrition when asked to do so.
- 6. Receive absolution.

7. Do the penance the priest gives you.

Suggested Dialogue

The priest greets the penitent.

Priest: May the Lord who enlightens every heart, help you to know your sins, and to trust in his mercy.

Penitent: Bless me Father, for I have sinned. It has been since my last confession.

Here state your sins. Priest gives counsel and penance.

Penitent says an Act of Contrition:

Oh my God, I am heartily sorry for having offended Thee, and I detest all my sins, because I dread the loss of heaven and the pains of hell, but most of all because they have offended Thee, my God, Who art all good and deserving of all my love. I firmly resolve, with the help of Thy grace, to confess my sins, to do penance and to amend my life. Amen.

Receive absolution.

Priest: Give thanks to the Lord for he is good.

Penitent: His mercy endures forever.

Priest: Your sins are forgiven, go in peace.

Penitent: Thanks be to God.
